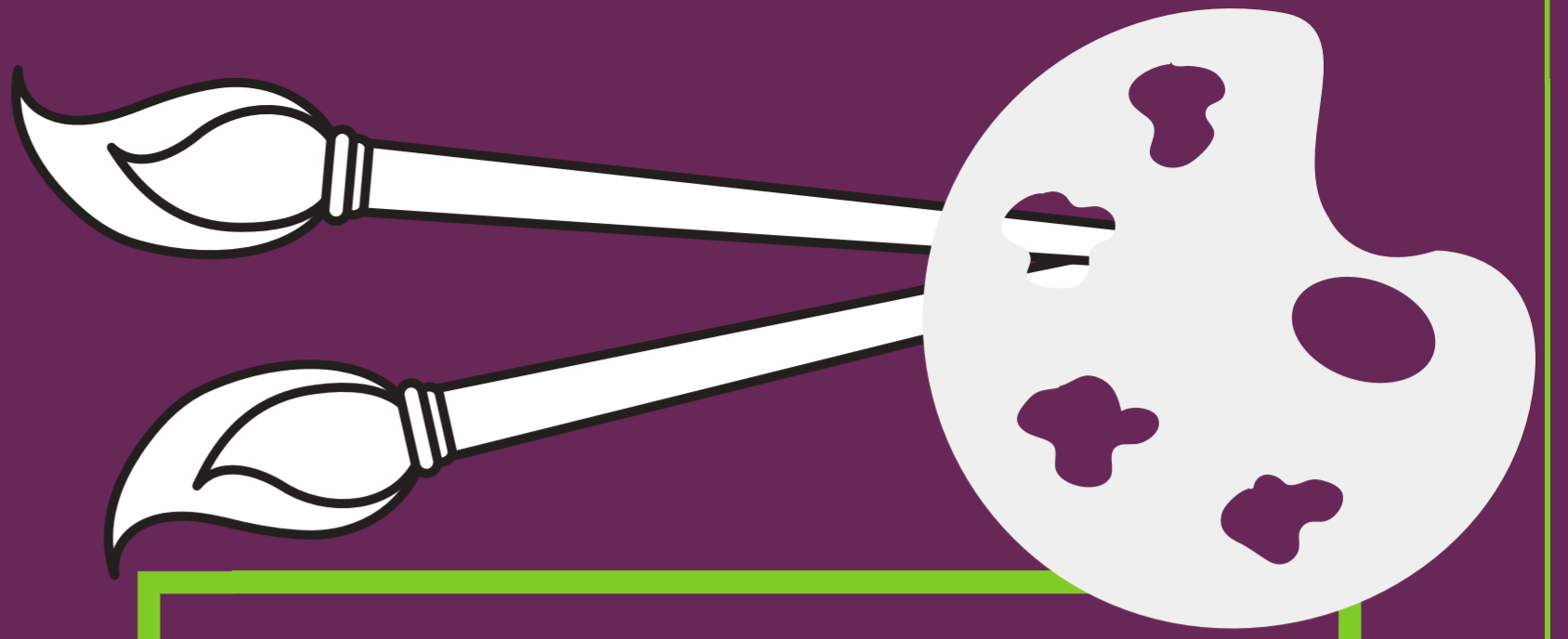


JENNA MAROTTI
